

6. San Leandro Residential: Interns have the opportunity to work with clients in Seneca's short-term Assessment house, Los Reyes. Clients in this house typically are in the program between 3-5 months. This is a co-ed house.

Direct Service Intern: Interns would attend the weekly house meeting (Wed. 11-1) to participate in a discussion of the child's behavior in the milieu and to update the team on individual and family work. The intern must also be available for the child's Treatment Review, a 90-minute meeting with the social worker and house team and a school representative to review the overall treatment of the child. Whenever possible the intern would lead or participate in group therapy at the house on a weekly basis. Interns should also plan to attend the weekly Clinical Case Conference with the program therapists (Mon. 1-3) when possible.

Management/ Administration Intern: Interns will have the opportunity to assist the Director in managing on-going and special program projects. These projects would include the development and implementation of program procedures to improve treatment services delivered to clients. In addition an intern would participate in various activities regarding staff training and development. The intern would attend and participate in the weekly House Manager Meeting as well as the Program Management Team Meeting.
